2011 舊生會週年大會 AGM

2011 年度的會員週年大會已於本年 2 月 26 日舉行，共有超過一百名校友和師生參加。

2010-11 年度舊生會會長伍宇鏢先生先向會員報告去年本會所舉辦和參與的各項活動，其後財務總監周允良先生向各會員報告和解釋本會的財政狀況。隨後，在各會員一致通過後，去屆各理事正式卸任。

在過去的五個，伍宇鏢先生一直擔任著舊生會會長並對本會及母校作出巨大的貢獻；理事會特別致送了一份極具紀念性的禮品以感謝伍宇鏢先生的付出和領導。



隨後，新一屆理事會選舉正式舉行；由於只得一份參選名單，以下四位人仕在獲得在場會員支持下順利當選：會長- 周允良先生；副會長- 劉鳳華小姐；司庫- 翁嘉升先生；秘書- 潘港漪小姐。

新任會長上任後動議撤消 2011 年度之會員費亦獲得出席會員支持而即場通過。



「城市定向」在週年大會前於校外舉行。是次「城市定向」比賽亦為舊生會與學校合辦之「啟導同行」計劃的活動之一，故各參賽隊伍均由數位學長與學員組成。透過這項活動，我們希望大家能對香港不同的社區有更深的認識，亦希望各學長與學員間能互相合作，加深彼此間的了解，增進友誼。

比賽舉行地點為上環，各參賽隊伍須於指定時間內到不同的檢查站拍下照片或完成任務，最先完成及取得最高分的隊伍勝出。當天，各參賽者準時齊集上環中遠大廈，聽過遊戲規則及安全守則後，比賽隨即開始。各隊由隊長帶領，先仔細看過題目，擬定好路線圖，然後即拔足向各檢查站進發。沿途各參賽者均十分投入，隊員間充分發揮合作精神，爭分奪秒務求取得高分數。經過一個半小時的努力，最後各隊均能於指定時間內返回終點，而冠軍則由伍宇鏢學長帶領其學員楊揚和周梓浩奪得。

在「城市定向」進行的同時，亦有超過 50 名舊生共六隊籃球隊參加了在校內聖母山對開的籃球場舉行的男子籃球比賽。為隆重其事，本會特意安排學界球證為每場賽事執法。

首輪賽事從上午 10 時開始，四強由每小組的首名與另一小組的次名競逐決賽權。經過連場惡鬥，決賽兩隊皆為同一小組出線的老對手 -- 「九十後」與「巨人」隊。最終巨人隊繼小組賽後再次取勝，獲得本屆舊生會週年大會籃球比賽冠軍。當日除了男子籃球比賽，Ms Evy Cheung 亦安排了一場由舊生隊對現役校隊的女子籃球友誼賽。在此，舊生會再次感謝 Mr Ko Kam Tong 和 Ms Evy Cheung 於賽事中的協助。



除了競爭激烈的男子籃球比賽，高中球場亦進行了由前羽毛球校隊領軍陳漢欽老師贊助，名為「陳漢欽盃」的男子雙打及混合雙打羽毛球比賽。比賽以三盤兩勝淘汰賽制模式進行，每組之勝出隊伍即可晉級次輪比賽。

在男子雙打組別，13 對參賽者中除了舊同學組隊外，也有同為舊生的父子兵上陣。經過兩個多小時的激烈比賽，最後由 Johnny Tang/Stephen Ng, Nelson Ho/Jacky Lee 及 Patrick Wong/Andy Chan 分別獲得冠、亞、季軍。

至於混合雙打組別，5 對參賽隊伍亦包括了父女及老師組合。最後，冠、亞軍分別由 Ryan Chan/Ms Sze 及 Damen Chan/Evy Cheung 獲得。

在各項比賽進行的同時，亦有部份「啟導同行」的學長與學員和一些舊生們選擇在學校的家政室內製作各式各樣的美食，以供各人在週年大會後享用。另外，本會亦很榮幸邀請到家政科老師 Ms Angelina Ho 作生炒糯米飯的烹飪示範。在短短兩個多小時內，各組別製作出多款具專業水準的美食。

週年大會過後，大家移師學校飯堂品嚐一桌子精心製作的美食- 中式小菜如生炒糯米飯，幾種唔同味道的雞翼，炸煎釀三寶；西式美食如大蝦芒果沙律，蝦多士，香腸卷，焗薯蓉，自製草莓果醬，比薩薄餅及；還有到會美食，真是應有盡有！在場人仕全都讚不絕口呢！

The 2011 AGM was held on 26 February 2011 in the school's Auditorium. Over 100 alumni and teachers attended the AGM.

Mr. Edward Ng, President of 2010/11, gave his report on the activities held by the OSA, and Mr. David Chow, Finance Director of 2010/11, reported on the financial affairs of the OSA. Both reports were unanimously accepted by the members presented at the meeting. Thereafter the Executive Committee of 2010/11 resigned.



Mr. Edward Ng, who led the OSA in the past five years, decided not to run for re-election. During his reign, Edward had contributed so much to the OSA and to the alma mater. The Executive Committee thanked for his service and presented a memorable souvenir to him.

As only one nomination was received, a vote of confidence was conducted. The members unanimously supported the cabinet led by Mr. David Chow. The Executive Committee of 2011/12 was hereby elected and is composed of:

President: Mr. David Chow (1978), Vice President: Ms. Lydia Lau (1986), Treasurer: Mr. Johnnie Yung (1978), Secretary: Ms. Conney Poon (1992).

The newly elected President proposed to waive the annual membership fee for 2011. It was unanimously supported by the members.

City Orienteering is an event of the RHS/RHSOSA Mentorship Program. This event not only offers the opportunity for participants to take a closer look at our local community and its history, but also for mentors and mentees to foster a closer relationship with each other.

The game started right after the players were briefed the game rules and safety guidelines. After reading the tasks assignments and decided for their optimal route, all teams started heading for their checkpoints. The team who finished earliest and scored the highest will be the winner. All along the game, players were very involved, all teams tried their very best to accomplish as many tasks as possible, they also demonstrated a strong spirit of teamwork!

While all teams were able to meet the time requirements, the score became the determining factor! The team who scored the highest is - Edward Ng and his mentees. Congrats to Edward – who is also the winner of last year!



While City Orienteering was taking place in Sheung Wan, over 50 alumni were participating in the basketball competition in our School's basketball courts facing the Fatima Shrine. The games were started at 10 a.m. and the six teams were divided into two groups, each with three teams. The first and second of each group would be qualified to the knock-out stage. The champion of each group would play against the first runner-up of the other group. The winners would then play against each other in the final competition. Each game was divided into four sessions, and each session would last for eight minutes. In order to minimize the variation due to age, scores were adjusted to average out the age of each team. The OSA treated the competition seriously and had hired four professional judges for the matches. The finalists were the "Post 90's" and the "Giants". Repeating the result of the group games, the Giants beat the Post 90's again and won the 2011 OSA Basketball Competition.

In addition to the men's basketball competition, a friendly women's basketball match was played between the alumni and the current school team. The OSA takes this opportunity to thank Mr. Ko Kam Tong and Ms. Evy Cheung in organizing the basketball competition.

At the same time, badminton competitions including men's doubles and mixed doubles were also being held at the Senior Secondary playground. The competitions were named after Mr. Damen Chan as Damen Chan Cup. Mr. Chan retired from teaching in Rosaryhill School in 2009 and had generously sponsored for all the prizes of the competitions. Both competitions were in form of knock-out games, the winner of two sets in each game would be qualified for the next round.

In the men's doubles competition, there were 13 teams, including a pair of father and son (alumni from two generations). After playing for more than two and half hours, the results were as follows:

Champion: Messrs Johnny Tang and Stephen Ng
1st Runners-up: Messrs Nelson Ho and Jacky Lee
2nd Runners-up: Messrs Patrick Wong and Andy Chan

For the mixed doubles competition, there were five teams, including a pair of father and daughter (alumni from two generations) and two pairs of teachers. Mr. Ryan Chan and Ms. Sze were the Champions; and, Mr. Damen Chan and Ms. Evy Cheung were the 1st Runners-up.

While different outdoor activities were taking place, some of the mentors and mentees from the RHS/RHSOSA Mentorship Program and old students were enjoying themselves at the "Cooking Party". After the culinary demonstration of "Fried Glutinous Rice" by the cookery teacher, Ms. Angelina Ho, the participants proceeded to cook their dishes for the "Food Sharing Session".

Subsequent to the AGM, a Food Sharing Session was held in the canteen for food tasting, the dishes were contributed by the participants from the Cooking Party which included fried glutinous rice, different flavors of chicken wings, fried stuffed peppers, mango prawn salad, fried shrimp toast, sausage roll, baked potatoes, home-made strawberry jam, pizzas as well as the food catering arranged by RHSOSA, which were very well received and appreciated by our members.

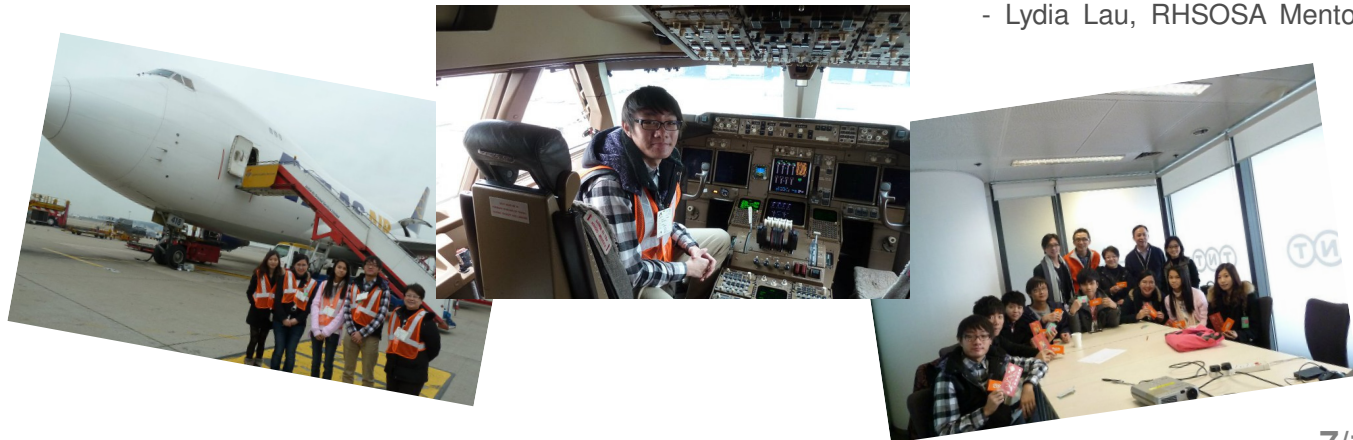
At the end, the activity was completed with a fulfilling 'Yum Cha' lunch in Siu Sai Wan and the restaurant was shone with our RHS happy faces!

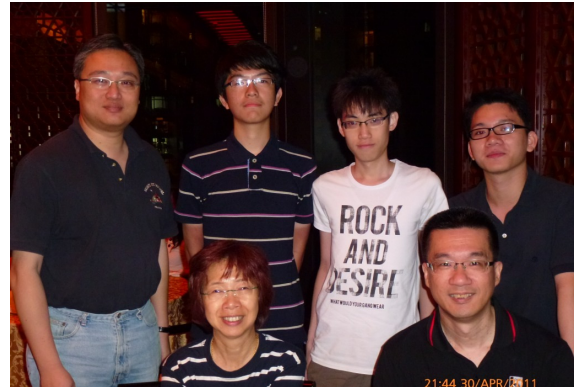
What is common between Inland Revenue Department & Hong Kong Monetary Authority (“HKMA”)?
